Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience providing the scope of work services of phase I and II. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience in Radon management. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.
Weaknesses
Firm's organization chart was unclear. Firm's proposal failed to clarify proposed team for Metro projects. Firm's company overview lacked detail. Firm's proposed project approach lacked detail for project management. Firm failed to respond to numbers 2 & 3 of the project approach section - Environmentally friendly practices & Reporting on ACM and RMS.

Strengths

Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience providing scope of work services. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's capacity to perform scope of work services. Firm's proposed project approach provided detailed information to include individual project examples. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Firm failed to provide copies of training certificates as required per the solicitation.

Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's capacity to perform scope of work services. Firm provided a detailed organizational chart. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm/team members have up-to-date training. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm's experience in sample collection. Firm's proposal demonstrated firm has knowledge of and follows proper industry guidelines. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.
