Strengths

- Proposal demonstrated an understanding of data matrix and reporting of real time data to Metro which shows a strong focus on data intelligence.
- Proposal demonstrated a strong understanding of Metro's Traffic and Parking Commission involvement.
- Proposal demonstrated a focus on education and community outreach.
- Proposal included a strong and details operational and maintenance approach.
- Proposal focused on compliance.

Weaknesses

- Proposal lacked detail examples where financial model has been successfully operated.
- Proposal did not have a consistent timeline for hardware replacement.
- Proposal lacked innovation approach and focused more on an operation management approach.
- Proposal failed to demonstrate how technology changes would be implemented in Nashville.
- Proposal failed to demonstrate a specific diversity mentorship program.

- Proposal included an option for permit list based on license plate.
- Proposal included pay by cell ability.

Weaknesses

- Proposal failed to provide an acknowledgement of firm's understanding key staff and substitutions needing to be approved by Metro.
- Proposal failed to address defaulting or bankruptcy on any project.
- Proposal failed to provide response related to detailed information regarding any felony or fraud convictions for any team member.
- Proposal failed to provide response related to any debarments for government contracts by any member, direct or indirect, of the Contractor team.
- Proposal failed to provide response related to litigation(s).
- Failed to provide audit financial statements.
- Proposal failed to demonstrate the respondents overall financial strength and ability to secure financing.
- Failed to provide a response to having any experience recommending policies and practices to increase turnover, apply data-driven demand pricing and/or progressive pricing, increase parking availability, and communicate where available parking spaces are located.
- Failed to provide a response to any significant and/or unexpected challenges of the project and how your team overcame them.
- Proposal was more focused on subcontractor information and not the role as the prime.
- Case Studies and project experience lacked detail compared to other offers.
- Overall proposal was difficult to read as it relates to the evaluation criteria of the solicitation.

Proposal failed to demonstrate a management structure. Proposal lacked detailed related to deployment plan.

 Strengths Proposal provided qualifications and experience within similar size, scope, and complexity as scope of work. Proposal demonstrated involvement with Nashville Airport. Proposal demonstrated experience with numerous technologies, including LPR Solution. Proposal acknowledged an understanding of Metro's stance regarding enforcement and stated the need to have re-assurance related to such. Overall proposal was well rounded comprehensive response. Proposal included audited financial statements. 	 Weaknesses Proposal lacking as it relates to equitability. Proposal identified litigations in the past. Proposal included case study that was prior to entity being taken over by LAZ.
Premium Parking Service, LLC	
 Strengths Proposal was heavily focused on innovated software solution. 	 Weaknesses Proposal lacks detail regarding equity. Failed to provide audit financial statements. Proposal heavy on technology and included things that was not requested. Proposal included enforcement even after Metro stated this would not be handled by vendor which demonstrated a lack of understanding of the scope. Proposal included Case Studies that were not aligned with scope.

 Strengths Proposal provided qualifications and experience within similar size, scope, and complexity as scope of work. Proposal demonstrated experience in Chattanooga which demonstrates an understanding Tennessee Law. Proposal included an equitable robust response compared to other offerors. Proposal included audited financial statements for 2017, 2018, and 2019. Proposal focused on compliance and writing less tickets. 	 Weaknesses Proposal failed to include 2020 audited financial statements. Proposal failed to provide response related to litigation(s). Case studies lacked details compared to other offerors including how merge platform was used. Proposed organizational structure lacks detail.

- Proposal mentioned litigation but lacked a response to the specific question.
- Proposal outlined numerous subcontractors which raised a concern on how everything will be managed.
- Proposal only included three out of the five case studies requested.
