QUALIFYING DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES IS THURSDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2013, at NOON. Candidates should file nominating petitions with the Administrator of Elections, **Davidson County Election Commission, 800 2nd Av. South** OR starting on **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2013**, at our main office which will be located at **1417 Murfreesboro RD (Genesco Park), Nashville, TN.**

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES to remove their name from the ballot is **THURSDAY, DECEMBER 26, 2013, at NOON.** The request to withdraw must be in writing, signed by the candidate and filed with the Davidson County Election Commission. Faxing a withdrawal letter is **NOT** acceptable. Withdrawal letters may be accepted at both election commission locations.

LAST DAY TO REGISTER IN PERSON TO VOTE in this election is **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2014, at 4:30 p.m.** Applicants may register to vote at both election commission locations, or by using a Registration-By-Mail application available at any Post Office, Public Library branch, or Driver Service Center. These forms may be delivered no later than Tuesday, or if mailed, postmarked by Tuesday, February 18, 2014. The last day to make a name change, address change or to make any alteration to a registration record will be Thursday, March 13, 2014. **PROCEDURES FOR VOTERS WITHIN THE CITY OF BERRY HILL ONLY:** Visit www.nashville.gov/vote and click on "Change of Address," icon. You can download the form, complete, date and sign. All forms **MUST** be scanned and attached when sending to: vote.questions@nashville.gov.

VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES AND ELDERLY VOTERS

Pursuant to the provisions of T.C.A 2-3-109, notice is given that if you are a disabled or elderly voter (60 or older) assigned to vote at an inaccessible polling location, you have the option of voting on election day, **March 18, 2014**, at either election commission office location of the Davidson County Election Commission.

Such voters who choose to vote at either location on election day must complete an affidavit at the commission office stating that their designated polling location is inaccessible. This affidavit must be received by the election commission no later than **March 8, 2014**. Disabled or elderly voters also have the right to vote at the election commission office during the early voting period or by absentee ballot. If, however, such voter has registered by mail they must appear in person to vote in the first election subsequent to their by-mail registration. If information is needed on polling location accessibility, the definition of disabled, absentee or early voting procedures, please contact the Davidson County Election Commission at 862-8815.
