REPUBLICAN PARTY PRIMARY ELECTION
TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2010**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to T.C.A. 2-12-111, that the Davidson County Democratic Party Primary and Republican Party Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, May 4, 2010, in Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee. This election shall be for the purpose of selecting nominees of both the Democratic and Republican Parties for certain local offices.

THE FOLLOWING OFFICES WILL APPEAR ON THE DAVIDSON COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT: *Circuit Court Judge, Division IV, Public Defender, Trustee, Sheriff, Circuit Court Clerk, Criminal Court Clerk, Juvenile Court Clerk, County Clerk, Register of Deeds, Democratic Executive Committee.*

THE FOLLOWING OFFICE WILL APPEAR ON THE DAVIDSON COUNTY REPUBLICAN PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT: *Juvenile Court Clerk.*

QUALIFYING DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES IS THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2010, at 12:00 NOON. Candidates should file nominating petitions with the Administrator of Elections, Davidson County Election Commission, Metro Office Building, 800 2nd AV S, Nashville, Tennessee.

NOTICE TO CANDIDATES FOR OFFICE OF SHERIFF: Candidates for the office of Sheriff are notified that the filing deadline at **POST (Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission)** for submitting affidavits and supporting documents for certification is **Thursday, February 4, 2010.** Candidates' failure to submit the necessary documents prior to two (2) weeks before the qualifying deadline will prevent the **POST** Commission from certifying those candidates' names to be included on the ballot.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES to remove his or her name from the ballot is **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2010, at 12:00 NOON.** The request to withdraw must be in writing, signed by the candidate and filed with the Davidson County Election Commission.

INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES: In order for Independent Candidates to have their names appear on the **August 5, 2010 State Primary and County General Election** ballot for any of the offices previously listed, a candidate must file a signed nominating petition by **12:00 Noon, Thursday, February 18, 2010.** If an independent candidate subsequently decides to withdraw, a written and signed withdrawal notice must be filed with the Davidson County Election Commission by **12:00 Noon, Thursday, February 25, 2010.**

LAST DAY TO REGISTER IN PERSON TO VOTE in this election is **MONDAY, APRIL 5, 2010 at 4:30 P.M.** Applicants may register to vote at the Davidson County Election Commission or by using a Registration By-Mail application available at any Post Office or Public Library Branch. These forms may be **delivered no later than Monday**, or if mailed, postmarked by **Monday, April 5, 2010.** The last day to make a name change, address change or to make any alteration to a registration record will be **Thursday, April 29, 2010 at 4:30 p.m.** **NEW PROCEDURES FOR VOTERS WITHIN DAVIDSON COUNTY ONLY:** Visit www.nashville.gov/vote and click on **Change of Address icon.** You can download the form, complete, date and sign. All forms **MUST be scanned and attached when sending to:**
