- ◆ 40 to 64 years of age
- ◆ Uninsured
- ◆ Have not had a pap test in 5 years or more
- ◆ Meet specific income guidelines

About Pap Test and Cervical Cancer

- * Each year, approximately 12,000 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer in the US.
- * Cervical cancer is preventable if precancerous (abnormal) cell changes are detected and treated early.
- * Human Papillomavirus (HPV) tests can find any of the high risk types of HPV that are most commonly found in cervical cancer.
