

COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 63-1

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SEAL AS THE OFFICIAL
SEAL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASH-
VILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Metropolitan Government to have an official seal; and

WHEREAS, heretofore there has been an official seal of the City of Nashville and an official seal of the Davidson County Court; and

WHEREAS, there has been designed a seal by Herbert F. Thomson, incorporating features of both of the seals heretofore mentioned, which would be an appropriate seal for the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT:

SECTION 1. That the seal designed by Herbert F. Thomson in the preamble of this resolution, be and the same is hereby adopted as the official seal of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County.

SECTION 2. That a design of said seal is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to purchase the necessary number of said seals to be placed in the appropriate offices of the Metropolitan Government.

SECTION 4. That this resolution take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
