

# IMPORTANT TRAIL RIDING INFORMATION

Trail riding is permitted on the designated horse trails only. Trail riders should enter & exit the bridle path system from the Equestrian Center at 2500 Old Hickory Blvd.

Trail riding is strictly prohibited on hiking trails, the Steeplechase track & infield, & over any jumps & fences.

All horses on Park premises must have proof of negative test for Equine Infections Anemia (Coggin's test).

Trail riders must leave Park premises in good condition. Littering & cleaning out trailers on Park property is prohibited.

Trail riding hours are from sunrise until dark. Use of horse trails may be restricted on certain days when organized events are scheduled.

Trail riders use the bridle paths at their own risk.

Organized trail rides of 10 or more horses require a permit which may be obtained from Warner Park Headquarters.

Stall use is by permit only.

Trail riders are encouraged to report maintenance needs and other information to the Warner Park Headquarters.
