Each January the Metro Board of Parks and Recreation revises the fee schedule. All fee revisions will go into effect on May 1, of each year. Events scheduled to occur on or after May 1, of that calendar year will be subject to these fee revisions regardless of when the application was submitted

Deposit Fees

<u>Key</u> <i>(Deposit required to receive a venue key, padlock key, water / electric access key. - Failure to return key would result in a loss of the full key deposit.)</i>	\$50	\$50
<u>Water Couplers</u> <i>(i.e. Water quick couplers & electrical panel connectors) Penalty fee is full amount of deposit)</i>	\$150	\$150
<u>Spider Box</u>	\$500	\$500

<u>Sanitation Deposit</u> <i>The sanitation deposit request is made to provide a monetary guarantee that the venue will be cleaned, free of damages, and vacated by the time and date indicated)</i>	\$250-\$1,000	<i>(Sanitation deposits are required for all events.)</i>

Special Event Violations & Penalty Fees

- Driving unauthorized vehicles on an unapproved park space:
(i.e. grass, athletic fields, pathways, and service roads)
Penalty – (\$100 per vehicle, per occurrence.)
- Failure to remove event elements by the strike-down / departure date indicated on the application.
(i.e. tents, portalets, staging, fencing, scaffolding, vehicles, cooking equipment and all event related equipment and supplies)
Penalty – (\$100 per day.)
- Dumping or failure to remove these items post event:
(i.e. charcoal, cooking oils, waste water, gray water, food service related items).
Penalty – (\$100 plus the full cost of labor and materials)
- Damage to any Metro Park property during the course of the event.
This would include park space or property that may not have been requested on the application.
Penalty – (\$100 and denial of all future event requests to Metro Parks.)
- Misrepresentation of event.
Penalty – (\$100 and denial of all future event requests to Metro Parks.)
- Failure to sufficiently clean the venues used for your event.
Penalty - \$100 plus full cost of labor and equipment utilized by Metro Parks staff to sufficiently clean the venue.
- Failure to obtain other required permits from Metro Departments
Metro Public Works, Metro Police Department, Metro Fire Department, Metro Health Department (\$100 minimum penalty)
- Use of any type of paint to mark a structure or hardscape surface
Penalty – (\$100 + costs of material & labor required to remove the markings by Parks staff, and denial of future event requests to Metro Parks)
- Use of non- approved event staff to control traffic at an event.
Control of traffic at any event staged within a Metro Park requires approval of the Metro Parks Police Department.
Penalty – (\$100 and denial of future event requests to Metro Parks)
