- Game room—flex space on ground level
- Restrooms—ground floor locker rooms and upstairs
- Youth needs 8 lane pool
 - Revenue generating
 - Tim discusses funding for construction and maintenance
 - Use groups historically don't support it
 - Parks would have interest in viable partnership
 - Worries about size of 3 lane pool for laps, play, etc.
 - Park interested in follow up discussion
 - Parks must live within means
- Sufficient exterior lighting for night time security included in master plan
- Views into fitness room exterior—don't like being looked at
- Ground level security concerns
- Native American history integrated into design?—Metro Arts
 - Public Art, timelines in sidewalks, history wall
- Football—field sized for football, concession stand & outdoor restrooms
 - Gary—provide large multiple fields, need field large enough for youth football
 - Tim needs to understand specific needs and dimensions—wants to meet with groups
- Regulation sized pools and fields can generate income, practice fields can't generate money, could host tournaments
- What happens if pool doesn't get built—area is landscaped
- Dog parks minimum 2 acres—land intensive, don't want too crowded
- Come see football practice in July to see use of space
- Should football fields run N/S—need to be lit
- Could courts move to south of building and expand football
- Regional centers operate more on weekends, extend hours 6pm-8:30pm
- Tennis is no longer being used, declining, use multi-use courts, function TBD
