Architecture structure similar - Dramatic exterior and interior walls.

Little to no natural feeling of connection to the outside from the inside

The overhead lighting was strong due to lack of natural lighting.

There were 2 flights of stairs to climb from the lobby to the activity rooms.

The building was not handicap friendly.

The front entrance did not have a handicap automatic door.

Didn't appear to have security cameras.

No sign of interaction of the community art work.

Very little sign of juvenile programs between the ages of 12-18.

Outside footpath widths were limited creating difficulty with pedestrian and bicycles.

Poor ventilation and circulation can quickly be felt when occupancy is at maximum.

There were signs of physical activity but no serenity.

Facility is well used on the weekends.

Architecture structure similar - Dramatic exterior and interior walls.

Windows are high for handicap and people below 5 feet tall.

Water conservation for the outside but no solar or wind set up.

From the lobby one had to climb stairs up or down the stairs.

The front entrance was not designed for wheelchair access .

There was one ramp on the side.

No community art work shown

Unsure as to what programs were available for the teenagers.

Does not have the flexibility to change size of interior

The ventilation in a high ceiling room is clearly a concern.

On the indoor track one can feel the heat.

The kitchen was against the wall which limited its use to the outside if designed differently.

The facility appeared popular amongst its community.

Would like to see in the J. Percy Priest Lake/antioch/Southeast Nashville Comm

No structure interior walls - Moveable walls adjusting to need.

Glass walls overlooking the forest, lake, park like settings, etc. from the inside
Handicap friendly , electric doors, ramp access to enter and exit, and emerge
