


















**Violent Crime Incidents,<sup>1</sup> 2015**




**Homicide Incidents, 2011-2015<sup>3</sup>**




**Gunshot Injury Incidents,<sup>2</sup> 2011-2015<sup>3</sup>**














# Homicide Incidents 2001 - 2016\*





# Robbery Incidents 2001 - 2016\*





# Aggravated Assault Incidents 2001 - 2016\*





# Aggravated Assaults with Gunshot Injury 2001 - 2016\*


