





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











- 4) **Poor health outcomes**





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









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

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

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



Median **Workers** Income - \$28,900

Four Council Districts have Median Workers Income **less than \$20,000** (5, 18, 19, and 21).


Six Council Districts have Median Workers Income of **more than \$40,000** (23, 24, 25, 31, 34, and 35).



Percent Unemployed Age 16 and Over = 8.2%


Five Council Districts (22, 24, 25, 34, and 35) have **less than 5%** of the population age 16 and over who are unemployed.

Seven Council Districts (2, 3, 5, 9, 17, 19, and 21) have **more than 12%** unemployed.



Percent Foreign-Born – 11.8%

Six Council Districts have **more than 20%** of the population who were foreign born.
