Purpose:	To establish guidelines for street paving and related activities to alleviate standing water and/or improve the function of stormwater drainage systems.
Policy:	<p>Paving activities are generally considered the responsibility of Metro Public Works (MPW). When feasible, MWS will notify MPW of the required paving activities and offer MPW the opportunity to perform the required paving activities. However, MWS will perform minor paving and related activities necessary to solve drainage concerns as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. MWS may perform paving activities to correct low areas that result in appreciable standing water. 2. MWS may perform paving activities to correct low areas that result in stormwater bypassing the intended Inlet or drainage structure. 3. MWS may perform paving activities such as the installation of asphalt curbs or berms to contain, direct, or redirect stormwater runoff as necessary to alleviate a drainage concern.
