<b>Purpose:</b>	To establish a policy to omit impervious surfaces for trails when determining the total Impervious Area (IA) for a parcel for the purpose of establishing the monthly Stormwater User Fee.
<b>Policy:</b>	<p>Paved walking, bike or multi-purpose trails will not be measured or counted when determining the IA for a parcel to establish the monthly Stormwater User Fee. This policy applies to both public and private trails whether on public lands, common open space, or in easements on private property.</p> <p>Paved parking lots at trailheads will be counted as IA for the purpose of establishing the monthly Stormwater User Fee.</p> <p>Impervious Area is defined by BL2009-407.</p>
