On behalf of Council Members Jeff Syracuse and Kevin Rhoten, Metro Water Services cordially invites you to attend a community meeting to discuss the upcoming infrastructure improvements in the area shown on the enclosed sketch. The meeting is intended to provide information concerning the scope of the project and to address any issues or concerns that you may have.

The purpose of the project is to provide system redundancy for the Donelson / Hermitage area and to improve system pressure and minimize large service area interruptions.

The project involves the construction of a 60-inch water main along Elm Hill Pike from McGavock Pike to Old Elm Hill Pike, from Old Elm Hill Pike to Old Donelson Pike, from Old Donelson Pike to Nodyne Drive, from Nodyne Drive to Donelson Pike, and from Donelson Pike to Lebanon Road. The 60-inch water main ends at Lebanon Road. The project continues with a 36-inch main in Lebanon Road from Donelson Pike to Central Pike. The 36-inch main will cross under the Stones River and connect to the existing 24-inch main at the intersection of Lebanon Road and Central Pike. Please see enclosed sketch.


