Oil from parking lots, leaking vehicles, and improper containers run into storm drains, which lead to our streams.



Help keep our streams beautiful by:
properly storing and disposing of automotive fluids



How you can help:

- ◆ Maintain your vehicle: Fixing leaks could save your vehicle and our streams.
- ◆ Perform maintenance indoors, when possible.
- ◆ If outdoors, perform all vehicle maintenance on level ground, away from ditches, drains, or streams.
- ◆ Always use drip pans beneath your vehicle while performing maintenance.
- ◆ Dispose of or Recycle oil and other fluids at proper locations.



- ◆ Never down the storm drain.
- ◆ Never on the ground or in a ditch.

- ◆ Use a funnel to prevent spills.
- ◆ Clean up spills immediately with absorbent material.
