

Plastic, Tin and Aluminum Containers



Soda, Water & Flavored Beverage Bottles



Milk and Juice Jugs



Food Containers



Aluminum Cans, Trays & Foil



Steel Cans and Tins



Plastic Buckets



Narrow Neck Containers

Paper Products - Anything That Tears (non-soiled paper ONLY)



Newspaper, including inserts
(remove plastic sleeves)



Cardboard
(no waxed cardboard)



Kraft (brown paper) Bags



Carrier Stock
(soda can carrying cases, cereal boxes)



Folders, Notebooks, 3-Hole Paper & Paper Cylinder Containers



Junk Mail & Envelopes



Paper Back Books
(no hard cover books)



Magazines, Catalogs & Telephone Books



Aseptic Containers
(milk and juice cartons)

MATERIALS MUST BE LOOSE

Notes: 1. No glass. 2. No motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers. 3. All containers must be emptied and rinsed. 4. No styrofoam or expanded foam containers, no restroom papers, papers that contain synthetic materials, or that are contaminated with food.
