Korean Veterans Memorial Bridge Lighting Policy - Effective 08/2015

The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County (Metro) updated the bridge lighting on the Korean Veterans Memorial Bridge (KVB Bridge) in July 2015. The lighting includes the option to program multi-color lighting sequences to illuminate the bridge arches. This document is to define guidelines for this special lighting. The bridge's default color will be white or blue.

Lighting Authority/Responsibility

Lighting of the KVB Bridge in various colors or lighting sequences can promote Metro, its civic institutions, state and federal holidays, and other public events of broad community significance.

Metro Public Works is responsible for the lighting composition of the bridge with specialty colors. Lighting requests from groups or individuals requesting to recognize a specific cause or to commemorate or enhance a specific event with broad community interest may be considered on a limited basis. Specifically excluded would be lighting to celebrate birthdays, personal anniversaries, or events that are primarily private in nature.

City, state and federal holidays and recognitions of special significance (including city-sponsored and/or public events or occasions deemed appropriate), may be commemorated with special light sequences – see examples below. In most cases, the lighting sequence will begin within three (3) days in advance of the holiday or event and terminate within three (3) days after.

- Martin Luther King Day
- Valentine's Day
- President's Day
- Saint Patrick's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- September 11 / 9-11
- Halloween
- Veteran's Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Hanukkah
- Christmas Day
