



METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY

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2011 CASE MANAGEMENT ANALYSIS—THROUGH FOURTH QUARTER

Summary of case management statistics in Criminal Court, 2011 compared to 2010, through Q4:

1. There were 5,619 defendants disposed in Criminal Court through 2011Q4. This was a 6.2% increase above 2010Q4. The average number of days from arrest to disposition increased 8.7% (+23.2 days). During this period, the number of defendants filed in Criminal Court increased 2.2%, from 9,627 to 9,839 defendants.
2. The number of defendants disposed by indictment increased 8.4% above the same time period in 2010. Defendants filed in Criminal Court on Presentments/Indictments were up 3.0% during this same period. The average time from arrest to disposition for indicted defendants grew 5% (+17.3 days) in 2011Q4 compared to 2010Q4.
3. The number of defendants disposed by Information Agreements declined 5.1% and the average case age increased 7% (+4.4 days). Criminal Court defendants filed on Informations decreased 4.6% in 2011Q4, compared to the same period in 2010.
4. There were 6.3% more defendants disposed without a trial in 2011Q4 than in 2010Q4. The case age for non-trial defendants increased 9.6% (+24.6 days). Defendants disposed by trial increased 0.7% (from 136 to 137 defendants), while the case age for trial defendants decreased 2.5% (-14.8 days).
5. Jailed defendants disposed in Criminal Court decreased 2.1% through 2011Q4. The defendants took slightly longer to process from arrest to disposition compared to the same period 2010: 0.8 day more on average. Disposed defendants on bond grew 13.6% in 2011Q4 above 2010Q4. The average number of days from arrest to disposition for bond defendants increased by 29.7 days (+8.7%).
6. The total number of defendants issued a capias in Criminal Court increased 16.7% in 2011Q4. There were 58 more defendants than in 2010Q4. The impact of these capiases on the average case processing time was 6.1 days, which was 0.8 day longer than the same period in 2010.
7. The number of defendants with disposed probation violations in Criminal Court increased 6.8% (from 3,235 to 3,456) in 2011Q4 compared to 2010Q4. The average number of days from arrest to PV disposition was 30.6 days, which was an increase of 2.6 days (+9.3%) above 2010Q4.

Summary of case management statistics in General Sessions Court, 2011 compared to 2010, through Q4:

1. There were 69,237 defendants disposed in General Sessions Court through 2011Q4. This was 1.2% fewer than in 2010Q4. The average case age from arrest to disposition increased 3.2% (+2.3 days). The number of defendants filed in General Sessions Court during this period declined 6.0% below 2010Q4.
2. The number of defendants boundover decreased 4.4%, and the average case age to boundover decreased 7.8% (-3.8 days).
3. Defendants whose warrants were concluded without a trial decreased 0.9% in 2011Q4 compared to the same period last year. The average time from arrest to disposition for this group increased 4.1% (+3.1 days).
4. The number of jailed defendants decreased 4.6%, while the average time to dispose the jailed defendants increased 5.5% (+0.4 day). Defendants on bond decreased 0.4%, while the average case age for this group increased 1.6% (+1.5 days).
5. The number of defendants issued a capias increased 12% in 2011Q4 (463 more defendants). The impact that the capiases had on the average case age was 5.1 days, which was 0.7 day longer than the same period last year.

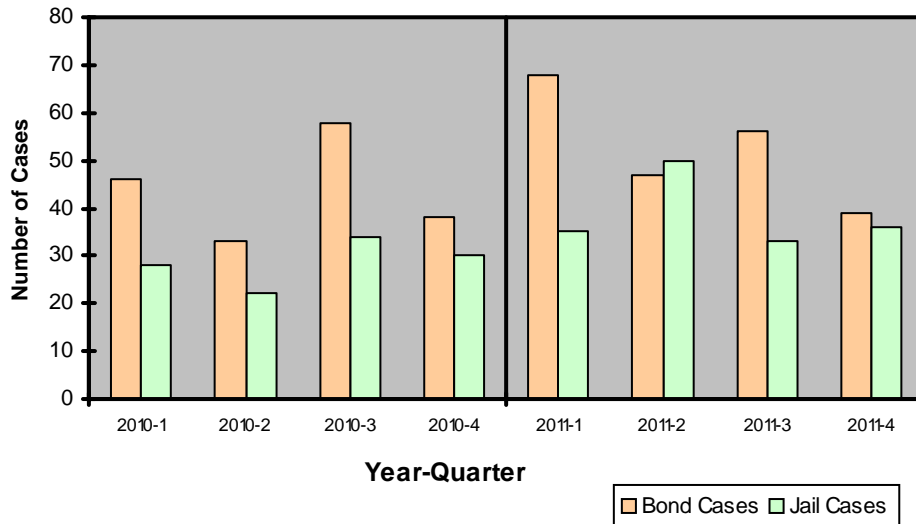

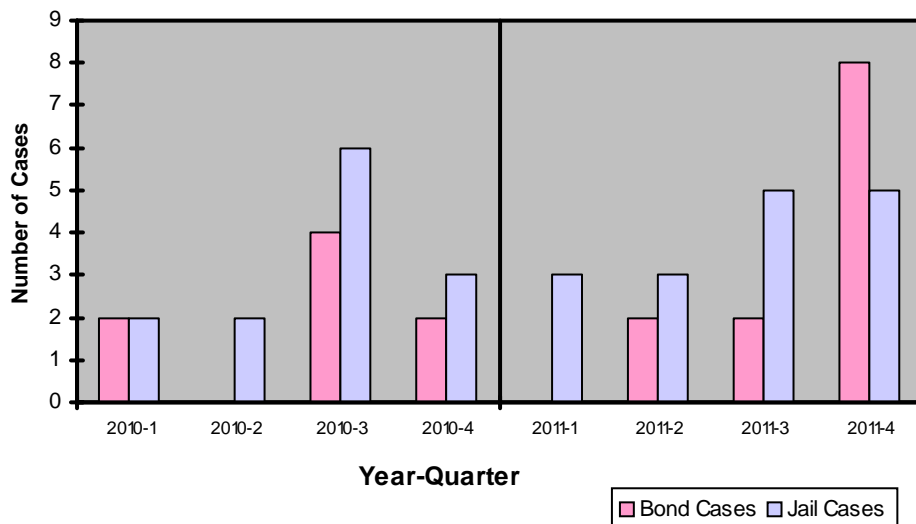
Disposed Without a Trial Number of Cases



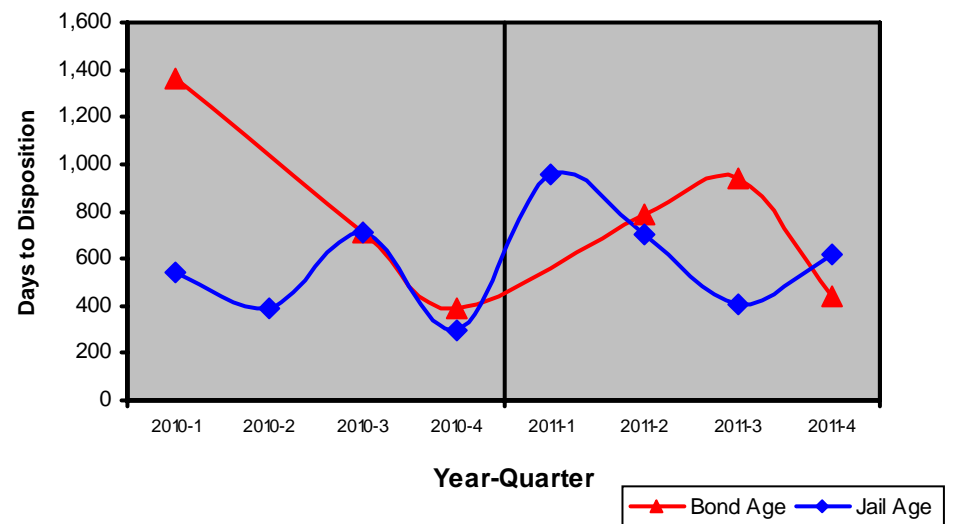
Disposed Without a Trial Average Days to Disposition



Disposed by Trial Number of Cases

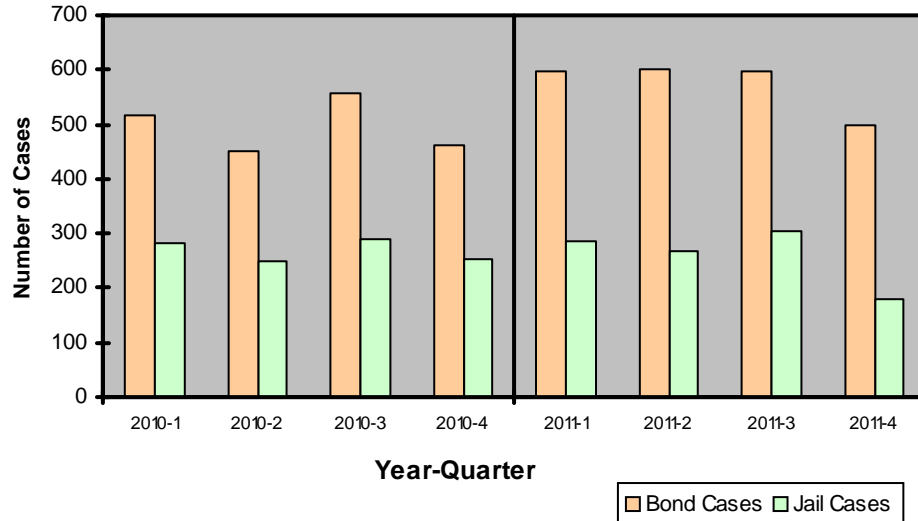

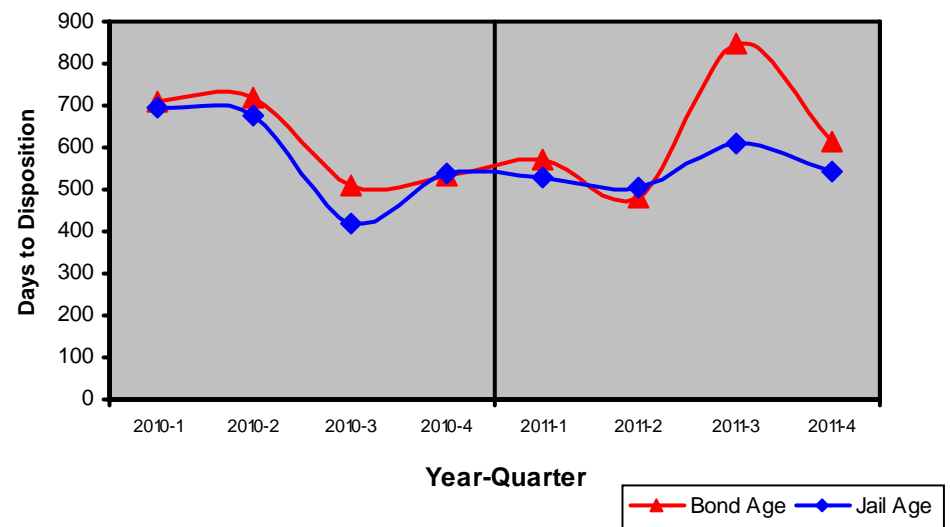

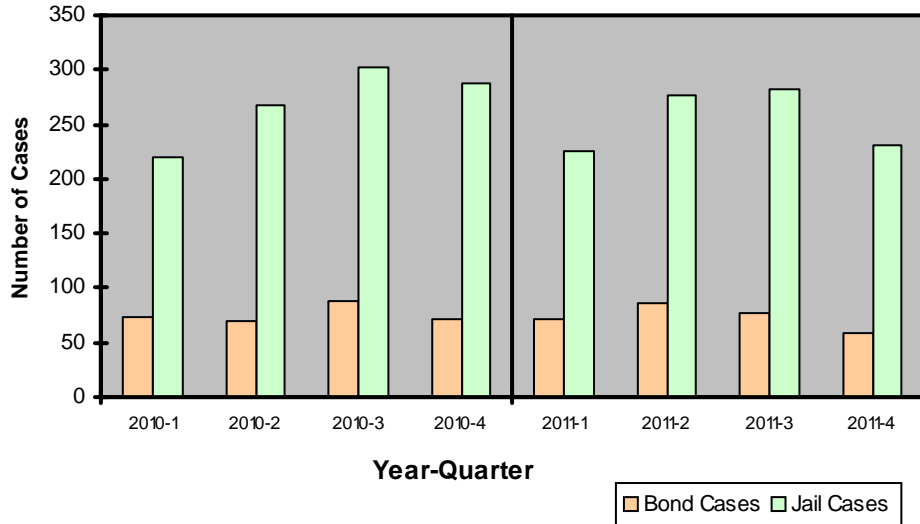

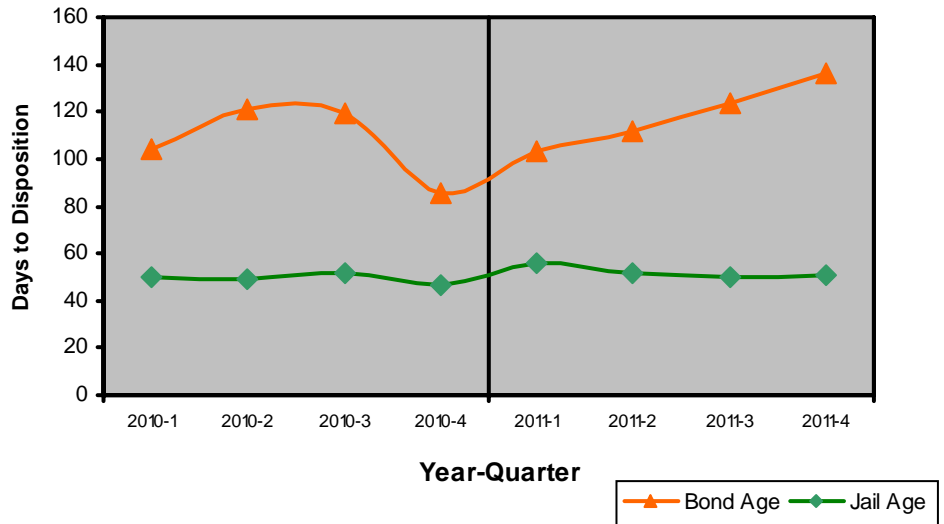

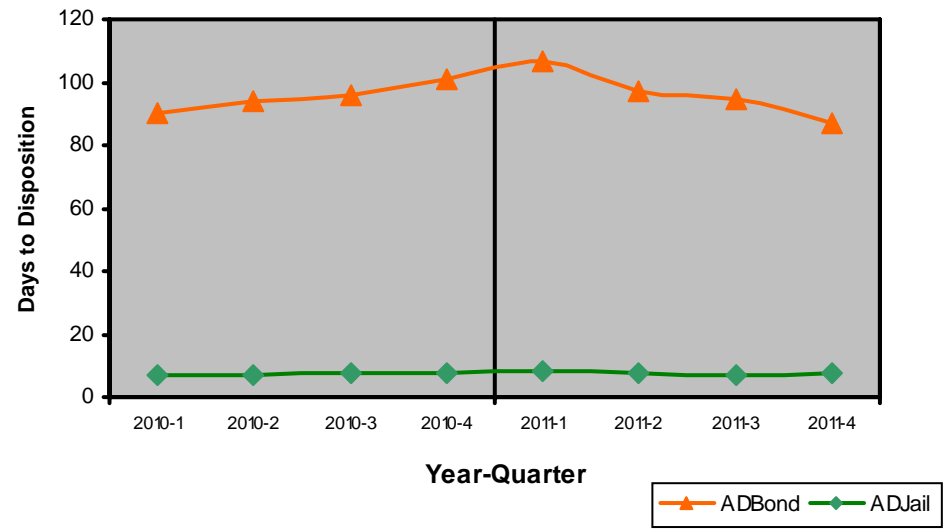

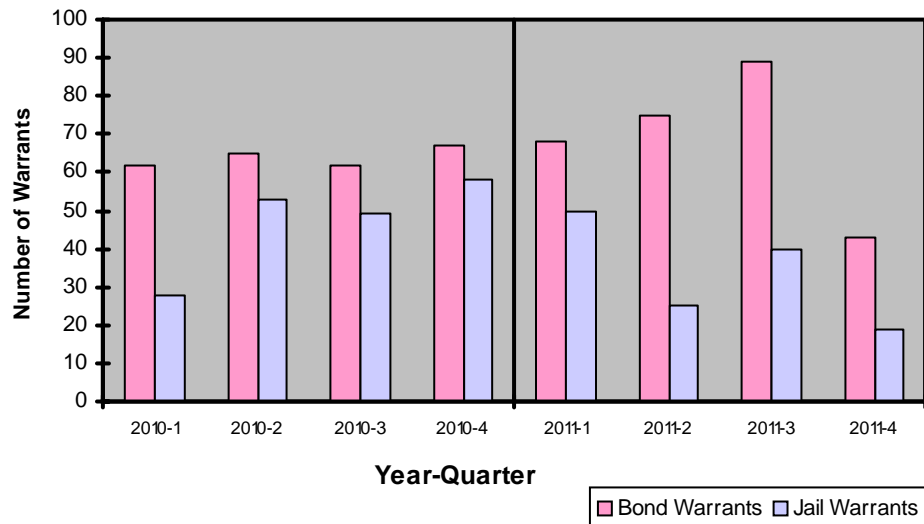
**Boundover/Concluded Without a Trial
Number of Warrants**



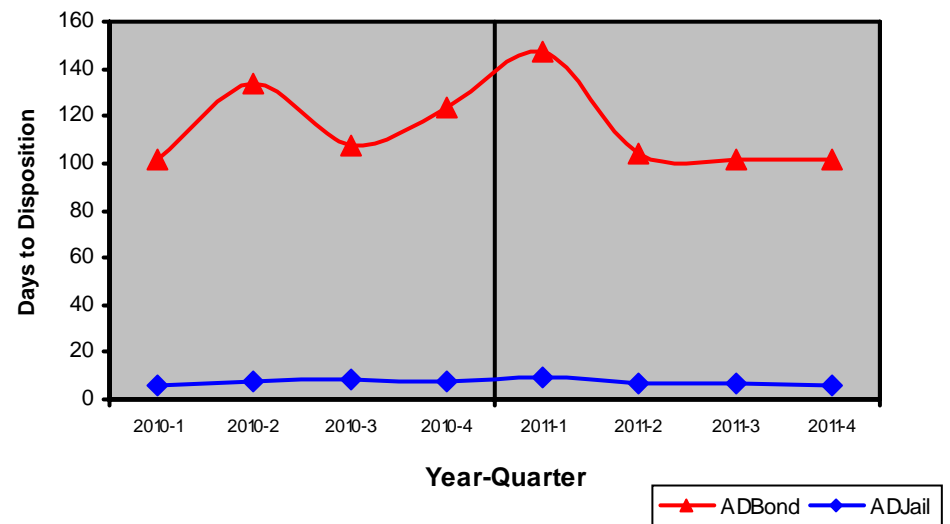
**Boundover/Concluded Without a Trial

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Appendix

Notes:

1. This report is provided on a quarterly basis as a management tool to criminal justice leaders. The purpose of this report is to assist court managers and judges in monitoring the flow of cases through the court system. Successful case flow management can help avoid and reduce unnecessary delay as well as allow more efficient use of time and other resources. This report was developed using guidelines established by the National Center for State Courts. It provides statistics on the average time it takes cases to move from arrest to disposition of the case, for the current year compared to the same time period in the previous year. This analysis is also available by Criminal Court Division.
2. For this report, an outlier test procedure of two standard deviations from the mean is used to determine extreme values which could skew the statistics. Two standard deviations around the mean account for roughly 95 percent of the data population. Values that are determined to be outside two standard deviations are excluded from the statistical calculations. Therefore, the number of cases and defendants reported here is not intended to represent the total number of cases and defendants disposed during the time period.
3. Criminal Court cases are included in this report when all counts for a defendant are disposed. Each defendant is analyzed separately. Therefore, a Criminal Court case can be included in more than one time period if there are multiple defendants with their final count disposed in different quarters.
4. Concerning data on jury trials: This report provides data on the average length of time to dispose a case/defendant therefore it does not include when a jury mistrials and the case remains open. It is also unable to distinguish when a defendant enters a guilty plea after a jury has been impaneled for a trial. At this time the data in CJIS provides no way to accurately identify those cases that started, but did not end, as a jury trial, nor measure the time spent in a trial prior to the guilty plea. Therefore in this report trial cases are defined as cases disposed and recorded in CJIS with disposition by either jury trial or bench trial.

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
