Prior to the introduction of an ordinance, a code change, a change in departmental policy, or a change in a procedure which may significantly affect the permit application process, the Use & Occupancy Certificate application process, or affect the use of real property, the development of real property, or construction thereon, The proposing department shall first submit "Notice" of the proposed change to interdepartmental review and approval by the five, above-listed department heads or their designees. The purpose of this review is to coordinate the change among the departments and to the greatest extent possible reduce impact upon the contractor/ developer customers of the participating departments.

## Outline Description of Change:

We will adopt the 2011 Edition Of the National Electrical Code (NEC) and Local Amendments to replace the currently adopted code, the 2005 Edition of the National Electrical Code and Local Amendments. This is a natural progression of Code adoption and presents no major change from the current code.

## Transition Plan for Change to Occur:

The change will have a 90 day grace period for projects being submitted for building permit. Trade permits tied to a building permit shall be issued under the code the building permit is issued under. Individual trade permits shall be issued under the new code the day of adoption.
