Minutes of the Davidson County Election Commission June 20, 2011

The Davidson County Election Commission (DCEC) met at 9:00 a.m. on June 20, 2011 in the Metro Office Building. Commissioners Lynn Greer, Patricia Heim, Steve Abernathy, Eddie Bryan, and A.J. Starling were present. DCEC staff members present included Administrator of Elections (AOE) Albert U. Tieche, Joan Nixon, Bobby Medley, Pat Novotny, Tom Cunningham, Lionel Barrett, Nancy Tice, John Rutherford and Kelley Harrison. Also, present was Ted Morrissey of the Metropolitan Department of Law.

Chairman Greer convened the meeting.

<u>Approve minutes from June 9, 2011 meeting</u>: Commissioner Bryan made a motion to approve minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Abernathy as passed unanimously.

Approve Election Day workers: Commissioner Heim made a motion to approve Republican Election Day workers. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Abernathy and passed unanimously. Commissioner Bryan made a motion to approve Democratic Election Day workers. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Starling and passed unanimously.

<u>Approve Election Day inspectors</u>: Commissioner Heim made a motion to approve Election Day inspectors as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Abernathy and passed unanimously.

<u>School Board District 8 Recall (Michael Hayes):</u> AOE Tieche informed the commission that the efforts to recall school board member, Michael Hayes, have been stopped. There was no further action taken.

<u>Discuss complaint against Councilman Bo Mitchell</u>: An official complaint was filed with the DCEC by certified mail from Alice Gadler stating Councilman Bo Mitchell had an improper witness to his signature on his financial disclosures. Councilman Mitchell was notified of the error and he filed amended financial disclosure forms. It is uncertain whether the District Attorney General will proceed with any investigation, but there is no further action required of the DCEC at this time.

Administrator's Reports:

- 1. Confirmation notice confidentiality- Looking into options of re-vamping confirmation notices.
- 2. Review early voting workers- Redistributing Democratic and Republican workers establishing a balance at the early voting sites- Commissioners reviewed list showing progress to date.
