Alley #207 and Alley #209 are no longer used as Metro alleys between Hume Street and Taylor Street and is utilized according to plans by the private property. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this land for traffic purposes.

None.

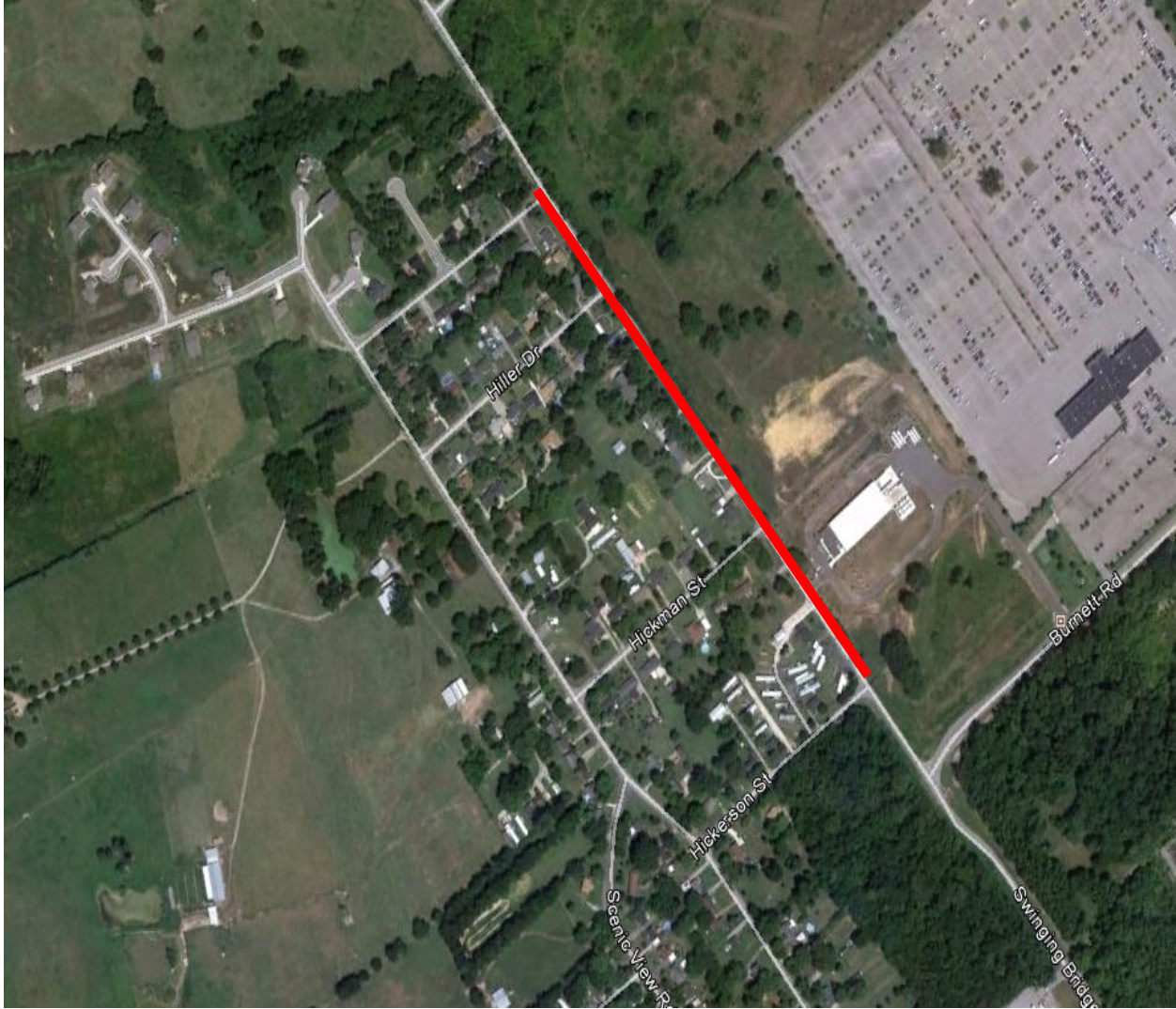
**DISCUSSION:**

The Commission granted this request for this event for the past 3 years and they are requesting the same complimentary parking be granted for the 2013 event.

According to the contract with the Nashville Downtown Partnership Section 8.H. no free parking or complimentary parking privileges shall be provided in the Parking Facilities but the regular charge shall be made to all persons, firms, corporations and organizations for the use of the parking spaces except as may be authorized by the Commission.

Appeal Item #1 – Appeal the decision by staff to not remove the truck prohibition on Swinging Bridge Road



DISCUSSION

The existing truck restriction on Swinging Bridge Road was approved by the Traffic and Parking Commission at the September 2001 Commission meeting. The prohibition applies to trucks over 5000 pounds on Swinging Bridge Road between Hickerson Street and Warren Drive.

The two-lane roadway is approximately 20 feet in width marked with the standard double yellow centerline and white edge line markings.

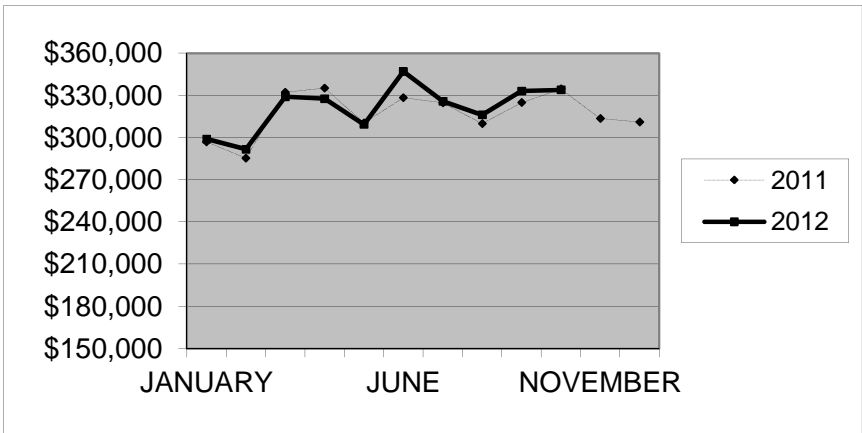
The conditions of the area have not changed since the original approval of the truck restriction. The residents of the area and the current Council Member are in favor of keeping the prohibition in place as is. For these reasons, it is recommended that the truck restriction remain.
