

# 2009 Prescription Drug Highlights

**Note:** This chart is a summary only. If the information differs from that of the official plan documents, the plan documents will govern. For details, contact the insurance carrier.

<b>Generic drugs</b>	\$10 copay for 34-day supply	10% of discounted cost for 34-day supply
<b>Brand-name drugs</b>	\$20 copay for 34-day supply	30% of discounted cost for 34-day supply
<b>Mail-order program</b>	90- to 102-day supply for 2 copays	10% of discounted cost for 90- to 102-day supply for Generics; 30% of discounted cost for 90- to 102-day supply for Brand names
<b>Caremark Retail 90<sup>2</sup></b>	90- to 102-day supply for 2 copays	N/A
<b>Pre-authorization</b>	Certain drugs may require pre-authorization	Certain drugs may require pre-authorization
<b>Other</b>	Quantities of some drugs may be limited	Quantities of some drugs may be limited

<sup>1</sup> As Metro's PPO pharmacy program is moved from WHI to BCBS, be sure to check and see: (1) whether your mail-order prescriptions will run out before or on December 31, 2008; and (2) if you have a prior authorization that has been approved by WHI, when your prior authorization will end. In either case, if your prescriptions have refills available **after** January 1, 2009, BCBS will ask that this information be transferred to them.

<sup>2</sup> Caremark Retail 90 is a new program offered through BCBS, which allows members to purchase a three-month prescription supply for the cost of only two copays. A list of Caremark Retail 90 participating pharmacies may be obtained by calling BCBS member services or visiting their website. This network includes most major chains, with the exception of Walgreens where members may purchase only a one-month prescription.
