Head Start, the nation's leader in Early Childhood Education, allows for enrollment of children with any diagnosed disabilities (also severe disabilities) regardless of income.

FREE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAM



If your child has a diagnosed disability such as speech and language delays, health impairments/deaf, autism and visual impairments, your child could qualify to be enrolled in the Head Start program, which is a federally funded pre-school child development program, which provides:

There is no fee for this program (with the exception of the before care and after care program)

School hours are 8am-2 pm.
The Metropolitan Action Commission Head Start program has 7 center locations and 3 partner sites
