CONGRESSMAN TO DELIVER FLAG TO MAC DIRECTOR, STAFF

BACKGROUND:

On Thursday of next week, volunteers from the Tennessee Great American Cleanup will completely transform the exterior environment surrounding the Metro Action Commission/Head Start School on 5th Avenue North. The project includes pressure-washing the exterior and cleaning and painting an old flagpole on top of the building.

Acting on a request from Nashville's Downtown Partnership, Congressman Cooper secured a new U.S. flag to be raised on the flag pole once the volunteer project is completed.

The flag Congressman Cooper will present to MAC Director Cynthia Croom and her staff on Monday previously flew over the United States Capitol Building in Washington, D.C.
