**Planning Dept. 2012 fee schedule updated**

**Hillsboro Village streetscape improvements to begin Monday**

**Public meetings: Blakemore Village May 21, Midtown zoning May 22**

On Monday, May 21, planners will discuss possible land use and zoning changes related to a proposal to develop eleven townhomes at 407 & 409 31st Ave. South. That meeting will begin at 6 pm at Metro Schools' Martin Professional Development Center, 2400 Fairfax Avenue.

Community discussions of a proposed comprehensive rezoning in Midtown (for this purpose, the area bounded, approximately, by I-40 to the east, Broadway/21st Avenue/West End to the south, I-440 to the west and Charlotte Avenue to the north) will continue from 11:30 am – 1 pm and 4 – 6 pm on Tuesday, May 22, at the Metro Parks board room, 2565 Park Plaza. The morning and afternoon sessions will be essentially the same.
