Reduce/eliminate apartments and condo complexes – too many people, traffic congestion, crime, ugly scenery. We don’t need or want Bellevue to become Antioch West.
- Bellevue is a great place to live, but is dated and disjointed. Sidewalks go nowhere, bus stops lack information, i.e. time of bus, where they go. No signage/directions for how to get places, such as Brentwood, Dickson, Percy/Edwin/Warner Parks, Belle Meade Mansion, etc. What is Bellevue’s history or goal at present – it’s just a small town with no identity, no appeal. What do we want to be and how can we get there?
- Public art: Street furniture created by artists that reflect character and history of Bellevue. Art trail created by artists and community groups to create sense of discovery when walking. Contemporary signage to orient visitors, businesses and residents.
- What happened to the library funds? Why do we not have a new public library?
- Will they replace the pedestrian bridge at the soccer field and connect the greenways?
- When will the greenway be completed? Connecting area by Ensworth School to Harpeth River Greenway.
- Eliminate street/pan handlers. It creates an unsafe feeling and appearance. Let’s connect these people with churches and companies that can create resources for them.
- No more apartments.
- What is really happening at the I-40 Exit 192 McCrory Lane? Details. Not road construction with commercial property? What kind of construction? What businesses? No hotel. How do we get out of that area during construction? *Another person agrees.*
- However we get neighborhoods to buy into keeping all drainage ditches on individual private property clear so they will reduce neighborhood flooding and danger to children playing in deep water.
- Why do we not have our own public high school?
- Is there a sewer line down River Road Pike (at Stringfellow Road? Can a sewer line be prevented? Prefer no sewer line.
- If you live close to Cheatham County, why not zone the area for Peagram School or Kingston Springs or just make us Cheatham County?
