This grant funding will continue to cover the full time position of Renee Bates, beginning July 1, 2012, for fiscal year 2012-13 with the addition of a 24 hour per week employee who will assist in development. Total grant cost will \$87,000.00 for both positions. (Parks will cover payroll tax only for the positions). Since the beginning of the initial grant in 2001 indirect (administrative) costs have not been reimbursed and Greenways for Nashville would like to continue this arrangement and reimburse direct costs only. In the event that Greenways for Nashville decides to discontinue or modify funding for this position a notice of 30 days will be given Metro Parks. Metro Parks may discontinue this agreement with a 30 day notice to Greenways for Nashville.
