Vice Chair Richard Fletcher called the meeting of April 11, 2011 to order at 3:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Richard Fletcher mentioned Ordinance No. BL2006-1050 regarding the appeals process of the Traffic and Parking Commission.

"If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met."

1. Request to extend the agreement with the Nashville Downtown Partnership to manage The designated spaces for the We Car Program for one year. Requested by Russell Payne, NDP

2. Request to reduce jury parking rate from \$12 a day to \$8 a day in the Public Square Garage. Requested by Tim Townsend.

Mr. Gene Ward asked how many spaces are being requested?

Judge Joe Binkley states that there would be approximately 180 spaces per week

Mr. Ward asked Ms. Marshall if there is space in the Public Square Garage, and if the jury parking rate was higher than the regular rate.

Judge Binkley stated that the rate is \$10 and they pay \$12.

Ms. Marshall stated that the rate was higher and that there is space in the garage.

Mr. Ward made a motion to approve the request from 8 am until 3 pm, seconded by Mr. Green and **approved by a 9-0 vote**

Traffic and Parking Commission Resolution No. 11-04 authorized by Chapter 9 of the Charter of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee as amended.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Traffic and Parking Commission of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee as follows:

SECTION I: That Chapter 12 of said Metropolitan Code, said Chapter being entitled 'Vehicles and Traffic' is amended as follows:

Authorize Stop on Manorview Circle at Hearthstone Circle
Authorize Stop on Millbridge Bay at Harvest Grove Dr
Authorize Stop on Springhouse Way at Fireside Dr

Section B: .25/10 mins, 1.50/Hour, limit 2 hours

ADD:

4th Ave S, east side from Molly St to Korean Vets Blvd

Section I-1: 1.00/1 Hour, Limit 2 Hours

DELETE:

29th Av N, both sides from Poston Av to Burch Av

Section R: .25/10 mins, 1.50/Hour, Limit 2 Hours

ADD:

Korean Vets Blvd, north side from 120'from Korean Vets to 4th Ave S

4th Ave S, east side (North of Korean Vets Blvd), 50', Guest Registration Only (Hampton Inn)
12th Ave N, east side (12th ave N),', Loading Zone at 12th Ave N and Grundy (Grundy St)
Almond St, west side (310 4th Ave S), 50', Guest Registration Only (Hampton Inn)
Almont St, west side (310 4th Ave N), 190', Car, Bus and Vendor Loading (Hampton Inn)


