A request to abandon a portion of 12th Avenue South, including all utility easements, within portion of right-of-way adjacent to property located at 2516 12th Avenue South. Requested By: Paul McRedmond, Owner. (Council Member Sandra Moore, District 17)

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The staff is recommending approval.

DISCUSSION

The portion of 12th Avenue South to be abandoned is partially paved and is used for access to private property. Metro Public Works has plans to utilize this right-of-way for traffic purposes.

COUNCIL BILL STATUS

A Council Bill has not been filed for the November 15, 2011 Metro Council meeting date. The Planning Department administratively approved this mandatory referral on September 21, 2011.

The Junior League of Nashville is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving the community through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers.

The money raised during the event will be used to further enable the Junior League to fund their work in the Nashville community. They are requesting approximately 40 spaces each day of the event.

According to the contract with the Nashville Downtown Partnership Section 8.H. no free parking or complimentary parking privileges shall be provided in the Parking Facilities but the regular charge shall be made to all persons, firms, corporations and organizations for the use of the parking spaces except as may be authorized by the Commission.

The following Resolution items are in newly accepted subdivisions and are for record changes only and will be added to the Traffic and Parking Schedule upon Commission approval:

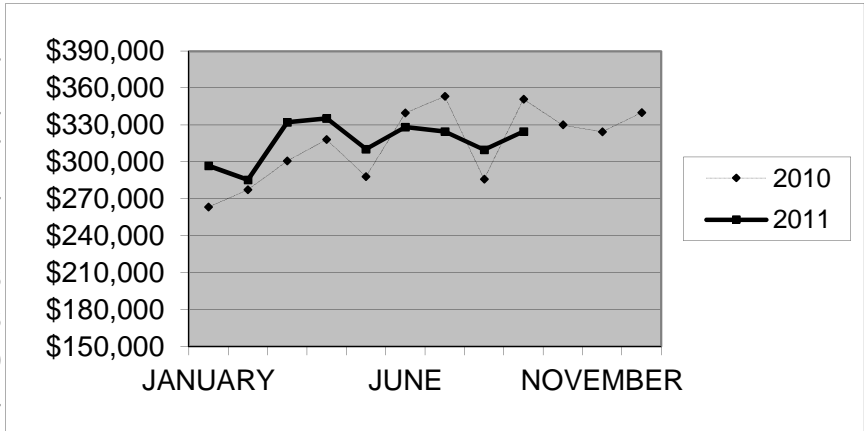

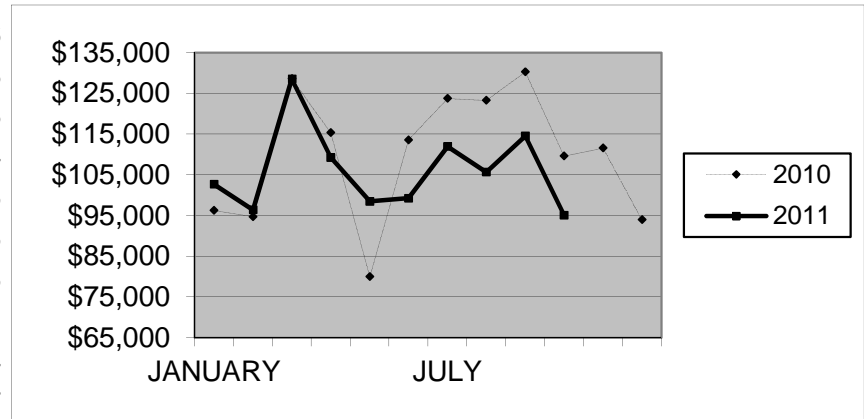

NEW BUSINESS ITEM # 2 - Proposal #2011M-010AB-001

A request to abandon a portion of Duncanwood Drive and to retain the utilities and easements within adjacent properties located at 1120 Glendale Lane and 1121 Duncanwood Drive, requested by John and Oleana Roper Trustees, applicants; John and Oleana Roper Trustees and Monroe Harding Children's Homeowners.

DISCUSSION

Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this right-of-way for public traffic purposes.

This proposal was originally heard at the September meeting of the Traffic and Parking Commission. At that time, the Commission recommended disapproval of the abandonment due to the lack of signatures from property owners. Representatives of the requestors feel that there is additional information concerning the proposal and has requested that the case be re-heard by the Traffic and Parking Commission.

COUNCIL BILL STATUS

A Council Bill has not been filed for the November 15, 2011 Metro Council meeting date. The Planning Commission will consider the approval of the Duncanwood Reserve Concept Plan at its November 10, 2011 meeting.
