This request is to provide complimentary parking for crew members that will be working the event:

- December 30<sup>th</sup>                      50 spaces
- December 31<sup>st</sup>                      250 spaces
- January 1<sup>st</sup>                              50 spaces

Discussion with the Nashville Downtown Partnership, who manages the facility for Metro, indicates that they do not see a problem with handling this request

According to the contract with the Nashville Downtown Partnership Section 8.H. no free parking or complimentary parking privileges shall be provided in the Parking Facilities but the regular charge shall be made to all persons, firms, corporations and organizations for the use of the parking spaces except as may be authorized by the Commission.

**NEW BUSINESS ITEM # 2 - Proposal #2011M-012AB-001**

A request to abandon a portion of Fransworth Drive (improved) from Harding Pike westward to a point approximately 320 feet southeast of Post Road, but retain the easements and utilities within, requested by H.G. Hill Reality Company LLC and Nashville Trust Co (SunTrust) owners.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

The staff is recommending approval.

**DISCUSSION**

Fransworth Drive from Harding Pike westward to a point approximately 320 feet southeast of Post Road is paved and is used for access to private properties. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this road for traffic purposes.

**NEW BUSINESS ITEM # 3 - Proposal #2011M-001AB-001**

A request to abandon a portion of Alley # 1806 (easements to be abandoned) from Hagan Street west to its terminus at the railroad right of way, requested by JJD LLC, applicants, JJD LLC, Hamilton Moore Partnership, Hamilton & Moore L.P., Queens Family Limited Partnership, abutting owners.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

The staff is recommending approval.

**DISCUSSION**

Alley # 1806 from Hagan Street west to its terminus at the railroad right of way is not maintained by the Metro Public Works and is used by adjacent property owners. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this alley for traffic purposes.
