

## Summary of Revisions to the August 2019 Solid Waste Master Plan:

### Executive Summary Updates:

- Page 1: Beginning at the bottom of the page, new text was added to provide an overview of the three implementation scenarios and highlight the Plan's flexibility relative to the overall implementation schedule.

### Plan Updates:

- Section 1, Page 1-3: Revised text in 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph at the top of the page to maintain consistency with language used in Appendix A.
- Section 1, Page 1-3: Revised second paragraph to emphasize the potential benefits presented in the triple bottom line analysis.
- Section 1, Page 1-3: New text was added to provide an overview of the three implementation scenarios and highlight the Plan's flexibility relative to the overall implementation schedule.
- Section 4, Page 4-4: Table 4-1 – Citizen/Stakeholder Group Input – was revised to replace “food scrap capture” with “surplus food rescue” for stakeholder input “Implement food waste rescue and source reduction strategies”.
- Section 6, Page 6-1: A sentence was added in the first paragraph referencing the cost analysis presented in Appendix F.
- Section 9, Page 9-1: The conservative scenario diversion tonnages in Table 9-1 – Remaining Waste for Aggressive, Moderate, and Conservative Diversion Scenarios in Year 9 – were updated for consistency with values presented in Appendix F.

### Appendix Updates

- Appendix A, Page A-3: Revised text in 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph at the top of the page to maintain consistency with language used in the Plan Section 1 - Introduction.
- Appendix B, Page B-7: Revised text in second bullet point under Figure B-5 – Nashville C&D Waste Landfilled and Recycled to clarify the point that some C&D recycling goes unreported.
- Appendix G, Page G-8: Under ZW7: Surplus Food Rescue and Redistribution Ordinance, the NRDC Study reference was corrected to “Modeling the Potential to Increase Food Rescue (2017).”
- Appendix G, Page G-20: The scenario diversion values at the bottom of Table G-1 – Implementation Timeline and Diversion Summary – were updated for consistency with values provided in Appendix F.
- Appendix I, Page I-1: The conservative scenario diversion tonnages in Table I-1 – Remaining Waste for Aggressive, Moderate, and Conservative Diversion Scenarios in Year 9 – were updated for consistency with values presented in Appendix F.
- Appendix I, Page I-2: Paragraph I.2 Processing and Disposal Infrastructure was revised to clarify the relevance of mixed waste processing facilities and conversion technologies to the recommendations of this Plan. A reference to Appendix E – Research and Screening of Diversion Strategies was also added.
- Appendix J, Page J-12: Total tonnage diversion tonnage values were updated in Table J-7 – Tonnage Diverted by Stream – to be consistent with numbers presented in Appendix F.
- Appendix J, Page J-13: Total tonnage diversion tonnage values were updated in Table J-9 – Direct Program Costs (excluding Tip Fee Element) – to be consistent with numbers presented in Appendix F.
