 - Communications and education
 - Harm mitigation and supports for vulnerable residents
 - Support and training for Codes Property Standards Inspectors

Initiatives for equitable code enforcement

Education and Engagement

Promote transparency in the enforcement process and increase outreach community and education efforts resulting in fewer violations and greater compliance.

- Improve data collection
- Relaunch digital presence
- Create flow chart to capture code enforcement process
- Partner with community groups and organizations to promote code compliance through education

Housing Support Resources

Strengthen support for residents who face fiscal or other barriers to address code violations.

- Develop resource guide for property owners that outlines available resources related to home repairs and other compliance issues
- Develop referral process for Codes staff to refer tenant concerns to Housing Services Advocates

Codes Staff Support

Ensure that the Codes department has adequate resources, including training, technological support, and adequate staff to operate efficiently, equitably, and proactively.

- Create publicly available employee handbook
- Source and develop "soft skills" training for inspectors
- Implement training schedule for 2023

Process Improvements

Create standard and equitable operating procedures that promote health and safety while minimizing the negative impacts of enforcement on vulnerable populations.

- Increase Metro Law engagement and structure to support Codes department
- Update language in the abatement notice to be more user-friendly
- Develop policy to prioritize which complaints to expend departmental resources on
