  - a. At last month's April 12, 2023 meeting, the Board approved the *Amended*Economic Impact Plan for the Madison Station Economic Development
    Area ("Madison Station Project" or "Project"). With that, the Board agreed to
    execute a *Project Agreement* with the developer for each of the Project's three phases (i.e, Phase 1, Phase 2; and Phase 3).

The Project Agreement details the roles and responsibilities of each party for Phase 1, which generally are:

- (i) the developer will cause the construction of *public improvements* (e.g., roads, sidewalks, and other public infrastructure) and also cause the demolition/site prep work of the project area;
- (ii) the Board will issue its non-recourse Note; and for this non-recourse
   Note, the proceeds will be used to reimburse the developer for its
   eligible costs spent on the project. Reminder The Board will pledge the

property tax increment revenues that it receives from Metro to the repayment of the Note. (For additional details, please see "Summary of the Madison Project Agreement (Phase 1)").
