**To have a Residential Parking Permit area, at least three (3) of the following criteria's need to be met.**

- 1) Scarcity of convenient off-street parking for residents
- 2) Substantial use of neighborhood curb space by commuters and other nonresidents for parking
- 3) a quality of life issue; such as but not limited to, trashed from other vehicles, disruption during the evening after 10PM, or public service as garage disruption.
- 4) Proximity of the neighborhood to major "parking attractors" including employments centers, retail stores, restaurants, universities, hospitals, and tourist attractions
- 5) Traffic, noise, and safety problems caused by vehicles cruising for parking.
- 6) By reasons for public safety based on crime statistics and adverse crime in local area
- 7) Dense, historic neighborhoods having inadequate residential parking accommodations.
- 8) Demonstrated adverse impact on community from economic initiatives.
- 9) Consistency of the proposed regulation(s) to adjacent streets and/or other preferential parking districts
