Rules and Regulations for Residential Parking Permits

- 1. Permit holder must obey all posted parking restrictions except for time limit parking. Permit holders may park for unlimited periods of time in legal parking areas.
- 2. Permits will expire on December 31 and must be renewed by permit holder annually by January 10. Renewal fee is \$25.00 payable to the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure (NDOT).
- 3. Permits are valid from the hours of 6 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday and all day on Saturday and Sunday at parking meters.
- 4. Permits are valid for legally permissible parking spaces including those which have parking meters without being subject to payment of the required parking meter charges.
- 5. Permits do NOT exempt the holder from the observance of any traffic regulations other than the parking meter payment or time limits.
- 6. Permits are not transferable and are valid only in the area specified and only for the vehicle described on the permit.
- 7. A permit holder will have 10 days to apply for a new permit when changing vehicles. During this time, the holder shall attach to the permit a note explaining that they are obtaining a new permit for the new vehicle. After 10 days, if a new permit has not been obtained, the new vehicle will be subject to a citation (\$10.00) and risk being towed to the Metropolitan Tow-in lot.
- 8. The permit must be displayed in the extreme left-hand corner of the dashboard (driver's side) and be clearly visible and readable through the windshield. A vehicle bearing a permit that cannot be read by enforcement personnel will be subject to a parking citation (\$11.00).
- 9. Lost permits will not be replaced until January 1 of the following year.
- 10. Damaged, worn, or faded permits can be replaced by turning in the original permit. There will be a \$5.00 charge for a replacement permit.
- 11. Visitor permits will be issued only to existing permit holders. Visitor permits will be valid for a maximum of 14 days and are not transferable but are renewable upon proper application. Visitor permit fees are \$5.00.
- 12. Visitor permits are subject to the same rules and regulations as permanent permits.
- 13. Proof of residency for the residential permit area that an applicant is applying for must be submitted with the application for the permit to be issued.
- 14. The downtown area residential parking permit shall not guarantee or reserve to the holder thereof an on-street parking space within the downtown area (Metro Code: 12.42.150).
