- **05-24-03** Staff requests acceptance of a \$2,000 general donation from the Friends of Shelby Park and Bottoms to the Metro Parks and Recreation Division. Council District 6

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

- O5-24-04 Staff requests approval for submission and ultimate acceptance of the Blue Cross Blue Shield Healthy Places grant for the development of a Miracle Field and Playground at Cedar Hill Park. The grant valued at approximately \$5,000,000 will fund improvements including the development of a "Miracle League" field, an inclusive playground, accessible restrooms, seating, gathering arears, and concessions. The grant will be in-kind to Metro Parks. No matching funds will be required from Metro. No money will be bestowed to Metro Parks. BlueCross Healthy Places build and design partners will construct and manage the project. The grant also includes a Maintenance Fund that will help offset Metro Parks resources. Council District 3
- **05-24-05** Friends of Warner Parks requests acceptance of a S.W.E.A.T. grant for Fiscal Year 2025 in the amount of \$44,876.59. The grant will be distributed via quarterly reimbursements to Metro Parks.

- O5-24-08 Staff request approval to amend the current Greenway Easement Agreement between Metro Parks and the developers of a proposed multifamily use development to be located at 2nd Avenue North and Van Buren Street on Parcels 08205013400, 08205013900, 08205014000, and 08205013300 for realignment of the existing greenway trail. The Greenway currently runs east to west from 2nd Avenue North to 1st Avenue North, north of Van Buren Street and connecting to the existing Cumberland River Greenway in Germantown. The proposed easement amendment will include design and construction, lighting and landscaping, subject to Metro Parks' design approval, and maintenance in perpetuity. Council District 19
