Purpose: To define the field conditions that may indicate the need for coordination of stormwater maintenance activities with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC).	
Policy: MWS staff investigating a service request and maintenance staff dispatched in response to a service request shall make a determination pertaining to the presence of conditions regulated by TDEC. If the following conditions are present at the project site, the NPDES Section of MWS shall be contacted to determine the appropriate course of action: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Algae growth within the channel on rocks or other material above the water surface, 2. Algae growth within the channel below the water surface if water is present, 3. Flowing water following a period of 7 days without rain.
