ORDINANCE NO. BL2016-178

Mr. President –

I move to amend Ordinance No. BL2016-178 as follows:

I. By amending Section 1 by deleting it in its entirety and substituting therefore the following:

Section 1. That Chapter 16.28 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws shall be and the same is hereby amended by deleting subsection C of Section 16.28.240 in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following new Subsection C of Section 16.28.240:

C. In the case of a permit issued to demolish a building or structure, such demolition permit shall become invalid unless the work authorized by it shall have been commenced within thirty days after its issuance, or unless the work so authorized shall have been completed within sixty days after work is timely commenced; provided that extensions of time may be allowed as provided in this section. Within thirty days of issuance of any demolition permit, an affidavit shall be submitted to the director certifying the date that demolition has commenced and describing the nature of the work performed to date. All demolition described in the affidavit must comply with the definition set forth in Section 17.04.060. If no such affidavit is submitted within thirty days of issuance, the demolition permit shall be deemed invalid.
