WHAT PHOTO IDs ARE
ACCEPTABLE?

Any of the following IDs may be used, even if expired:

- Tennessee driver license with your photo
- United States Passport
- Photo ID issued by the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security
- Photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government
- United States Military photo ID
- Tennessee handgun carry permit with your photo

WHAT PHOTO IDs ARE NOT
ACCEPTABLE?

College student IDs and photo IDs not issued by the federal or Tennessee state government are NOT acceptable. This includes county or city issued photo IDs, such as library cards, and photo IDs issued by other states.

WHAT IF I REGISTERED BY
MAIL AND AM VOTING IN
MY FIRST ELECTION?

Federal law requires first time voters who register by mail to present one of the following:

- A current photo identification with voter's name and photo OR
- If the photo identification is expired, the voter must also present one of the following: a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the voter's name and address.

IS AN EXPIRED PHOTO ID
ACCEPTABLE?

Yes, as long as it was validly issued by the federal or Tennessee state government and contains the name and photograph of the voter.

ADDRESS OR NAME CHANGE

Have you recently moved or changed your name? If you are a registered Davidson County voter and haven't updated your voter registration, you should vote early at any of the Early Voting locations listed on the front of this sample ballot. If you vote on Election Day, you **must** vote at your new voting location. (Use the Polling Place Finder at www.nashville.gov/vote)

NOTICE:

MOBILE DEVICE USE
IN POLLING PLACES

Please silence any mobile electronic or communication devices.

You **may not** use a mobile electronic or communication device for telephone conversations, recording, or taking photographs or videos while inside the polling place.

You **may** use a mobile electronic or communication device for informational purposes to assist in making election decisions.

A violation of this act could be classified a Class C misdemeanor under T.C.A. 2-19-102 punishable by not greater than thirty (30) days of incarceration or a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), or both.
