

Cleveland Park Community Center

The Cleveland Park Community Center is a Metro Community Center that provides free open gym access on weekdays. This facility also features a full-size outdoor pool that is open during the summer months. Woodland Studios

The Woodland Theater was built in 1924 on Woodland St. between S 10th St. and S 11th St. as a movie house for the local population. After closing in 1955, it sat vacant until audio engineer Glenn Snoddy gave it new life as a recording studio away from the hustle and bustle of Music Row. Renowned for its sound quality, Woodland Studios has attracted the likes of Barbara Mandrell, Johnny Cash, Charlie Daniels, Neil Young and Kansas, among many others, to record there.
