

Fisk's Stieglitz Collection

When photographer and art collector Alfred Stieglitz passed away in 1946, his wife, artist Georgia O'Keeffe, arranged the transfer of 99 works from his collection to Fisk University. The selection included two of her own paintings, plus works by such noted artists as Paul Cezanne, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, and Pablo Picasso, among many others. Today, the collection is still on display in Fisk's Van Vechten Gallery (M-F 10-5 during the summer, Tu-Sat 10-5 during the academic year).
