**NOTE:** Due to increased demand, pottery students are permitted to register for only **ONE** pottery class per session. This includes classes at Bellevue, and West Park Community Centers. If a student is enrolled in more than one pottery class, staff will withdraw the student from one class at staff's discretion. At this time, painting students may continue to register for a maximum of two classes (or one pottery class and one painting/drawing/printmaking class).
