

METRO PARKS DANCE DIVISION ETIQUETTE

- 1) Respectful, courteous behavior is expected at all times toward the teachers, Metro Parks staff, parents, and other dancers before, during, and after class. While everyone is entitled to his/her own opinion, please refrain from speaking negatively about a faculty member, student, or resident artist in public areas. Legitimate concerns may be directed to the Dance Division Supervisor.
- 2) Dancers should arrive for class on time and in the proper attire. Students who are late should enter the studio quietly and will be allowed to participate at the discretion of the instructor. Students who miss warm-up may be asked to sit out to avoid injuries.
- 3) For classes taking place at Centennial Performing Arts Studios (CPAS), dancers rehearsing or taking class in Studios B or C should walk through Studio A as quietly and discreetly as possible and limit interruptions while a class or rehearsal is taking place.
- 4) Dancers are responsible for picking up and properly disposing of their trash (e.g., band-aid wrappers, cotton, kleenex, hair accessories, and water bottles) before they leave the studio after class or rehearsal.
- 5) Dancers are responsible for taking all of their belongings with them and vacating the studio in a timely manner at the end of classes and rehearsals to allow the next class or rehearsal to start promptly.
- 6) If dancers move barres, chairs, or modify the studio in any way for a class or rehearsal, they are responsible for returning it to its original state before leaving.
- 7) Only water may be taken into the dance studios. Gum, candy, food, and soft drinks are not permitted in the dance studios.
- 8) Only dance shoes, socks, or bare feet are permitted on the marley dance floor. Dance props or set pieces must be approved ahead of time by the Dance Division Supervisor. Rosin is not allowed on the marley.
