Metro Parks' Visual Arts Program in the new **Bellevue Community Center** offers popular, affordable painting and pottery classes in large, well-appointed studios.

Visual Arts Classes are taught by highly-qualified Guest Instructors who are local, professional artists. Our most popular adult art classes include drawing, painting, mixed media, and pottery. Affordable youth art classes provide school-aged children with an opportunity to explore and enhance their artistic abilities.



2D Classes (drawing, painting, mixed-media)

The Bellevue Paint Studio offers a variety of 2D classes including drawing, painting, abstract painting, watercolor, mixed media and collage.

In beginner classes, students will learn and develop basic drawing, painting, and composition skill. Classes in watercolor and abstract art will expand on techniques and skills related to that media or painting style through guided lessons and demonstrations.

In mixed-media and collage classes students will learn how to combine a variety of paper, cloth, wood, and found objects into cohesive art pieces.

Art Class for Children (6-10)

In this art class, children will learn basic skills associated with drawing and painting. Students will create art using graphite, colored pencils, acrylic paints and watercolor. Drawing and painting lessons will focus on proportion, color and shading. A \$10 supply fee will be due the first day of class paid directly to the instructor.

Pottery Classes (hand-built and wheel-thrown)

The Bellevue Pottery Studio offers beginning and intermediate level pottery classes which explore basic techniques of wheel-throwing and hand-building.

Beginner classes provide an overview of the complete clay process. Students will learn the fundamentals of working with clay through its different stages using various tools. As class continues, students will learn to glaze pottery and will take home finished pieces.



Intermediate classes will explore more complex shapes and multi-part pots such as cups, teapots and lidded vessels. Students may combine wheel-thrown pieces with slabs and coils to construct more creative projects. As class continues, students will glaze pottery to take home.

Pottery is a complex process which requires a lot of practice to gain skills. Therefore, it is recommended that students take the beginner class more than once before advancing to an intermediate class.
