### Q&A

- Where is sidewalk to get to site? No plans for sidewalk on Smith Springs Rd in project, could be a public works project could be prioritized with addition of park
- Need center turn lane
- Where is theatre? Would require large area, specific demand, more focus on multi-use space
- Swimming pool is strong desire, concerned about its potential. Karen Johnson says pool funding could be in next phase of funding. Great potential and desire by council to have each county quadrant with access to pool.
- This budget would be for 2016 projects. Pool could be the next year most likely.
- Will future pool require blasting next to new building? Site would be prepped for future building pad, pool most likely wouldn't need to be blasted due to its depth.
- Pool would be great asset for children to swim and learn to swim.
- Would there be soccer or baseball? There would be a large multiple use field. Baseball is available at Una park. Need court spaces, they are provided in master plan.
- Would Smith Springs Road be widened? Not a current priority but with growth, parks and schools could make it more of a priority of funding. Difficult to do, would require property acquisitions near Castle Gate subdivision. Could be a phased widening from Castle Gate to Bell Road but the remainder is unknown.
- Could there be a splash park for kids?
- Could there be a Frisbee golf course, 3 holes?
- Are evergreen or deciduous trees to be planted on the buffer? Most effective is evergreen trees and that is will most likely be the majority.
- Is there a plan for a dog park? Site selection needs to be thought about, need 2 acres minimum. Could be located in the corner near the pedestrian entrance as a suggestion.
- Outdoor courts? Will there be tennis or basketball? How big is the one planned? Just 'courts' for purpose of master plan intended for multiuse, decision for specific courts will be determined after funding is received. How big is it in relation to Sevier? The desire is to fit in what we can for the best use. Making some elements larger creates a tradeoff for other functions.
- Is there a potential for tower to climb to be able to see the lake? Similar to fire tower.

- Could we include in the master plan the property across the street? Could be future dog park.
