


<b>Purpose:</b> To formalize maintenance responsibilities for the removal of either live or dead animals from stormwater inlets and pipes within the public right-of-way.	
<b>Policy:</b> MWS will remove at their sole discretion animals trapped in public inlets and pipes. It will not TV a pipe to confirm an animal's presence. If a dead animal is removed, maintenance staff will notify Public Works for disposal.
