APPROXIMATE MONTHLY BILL INCREASE

The majority of our customers will see an increase of \$9 or less.
Less than 20% of our customers will see an increase over \$15.



We bill by the CCF. 1 CCF = 100 Cubic Feet or 748 gallons. According to USGS, the average person uses 80-100 gallons of water a day.
