


The K.R. Harrington water treatment plant was built in 1978 at the confluence of the Stones River and Cumberland River.



Metro Water Services provides water service to 191,000 customers in Davidson County and surrounding counties through over 3,000 miles of water main ranging in size from 2" to 60". Water is pumped by 53 water pumping stations and stored in 36 reservoirs throughout the service area. Each water treatment plant has a capacity of 90 million gallons per day (MGD) and the daily average water use is approximately 100 MGD.
