

WATER CONNECTION POLICY

In accordance with section 15.32 of the Metropolitan Code, multiple unit rental dwellings on one parcel of land may be required to supply each unit with a separate service connection and meter.

If a single parcel of land includes multiple residential and/or commercial units to be sold individually, the Director or his designee may approve a separate service connection and meter for each unit. Multiple meters must be banked and marked in accordance with most recent MWS specifications.

New water connection taps made directly to a common service line instead of the public main must be approved by the director or his designee. These will require documentation and recording of agreement by owner to assume all future liability and responsibility for the maintenance/repair of the common service line that is tapped.
